

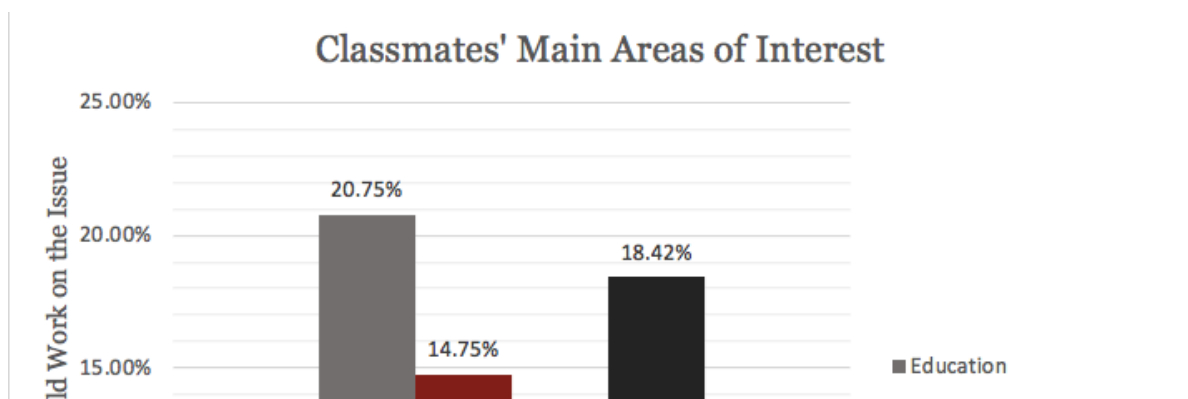
Survey Highlights

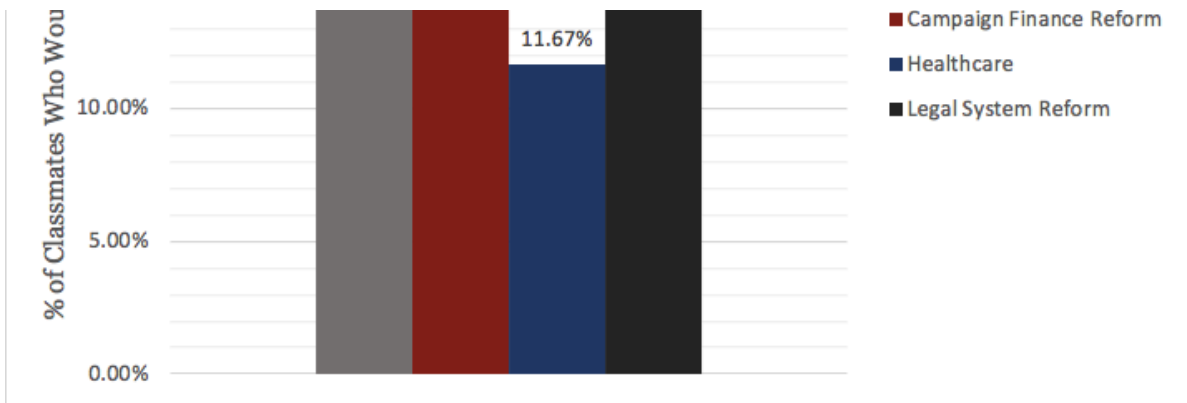

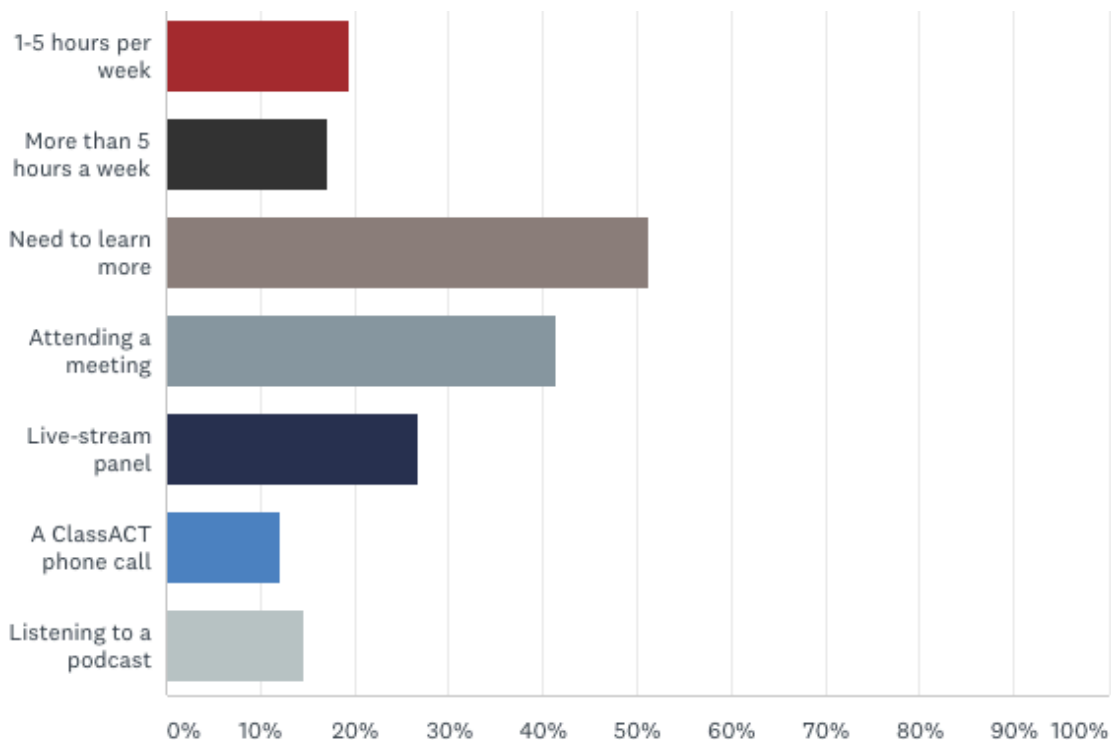




2. Just how committed are you?

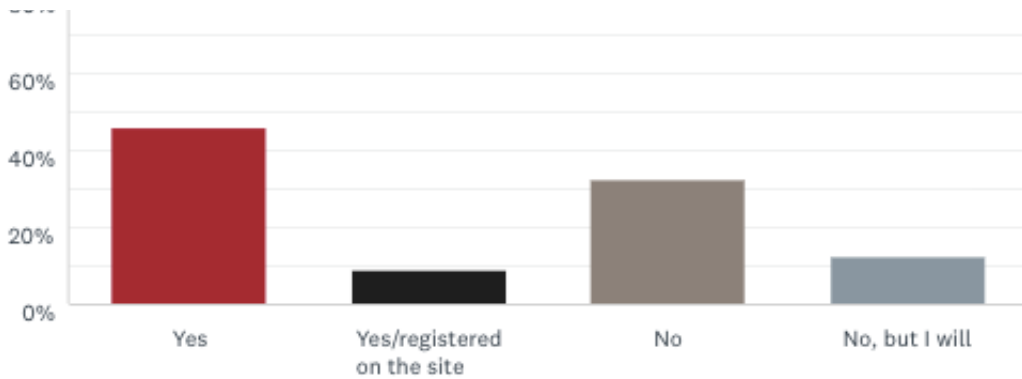
